What is the Church?

When most people hear the word church they probably think of a building. But biblically speaking, a church is much more than a building. The early Christian church had no buildings, at least not in the sense of what we would consider church buildings today. First century Christians were often persecuted and, as a result, often met in secret usually in homes. As the influence of Christianity spread, eventually buildings dedicated to worship were established and became what we know today as churches. In this sense, then, the church consists of people not buildings. Fellowship, worship and ministry are all conducted by people, not buildings. Church structures facilitate the role of God's people, but they do not fulfill it.

In the Bible, the word "church" never refers to a building, but always to people. The term ekklesia occurs over 100 times in the New Testament and, as was pointed out earlier, it always refers to a gathering of people united by a common identity and purpose, never to the building where the people met. Therefore, the entity Jesus built is a purposeful gathering of people; we are a Jesus movement.

Who is it for?

The church is not a building, but a body of believers with a specific nature and purpose. Its role is to worship God, nurture and edify other Christians within a community, and reach out to a suffering world with the saving message of the gospel. The church, like God's grace, is not just for church people; it is for people people. All people. Everybody.

Some in the church like to talk about the Great Commission, sing songs about the Great Commission, but refuse to organize around the Great Commission. The church is God's medium for exporting, illustrating, and modeling the grace of God in this world. This is the mission of the church. The church is the steward of His grace. And the church is to make God's grace accessible to everyone.

After all; it's not the church's grace. It's not my grace. It's God's grace. And it's for everybody.
