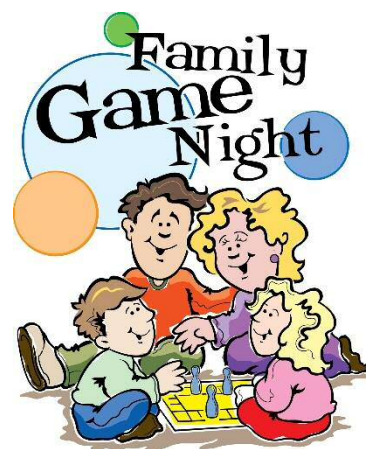

Greater #5: Where Did it Fall?

In God's economy, our setbacks in life can be setups to seeing God's glory in places we didn't even know to look.

Points to Remember

- God is always working behind the scenes, engineering our circumstances and setting us up for success.
- We can thrive in the toughest circumstances because we know that impossible odds set the stage for amazing miracles.
- The mistake most of us make when it comes to God is that we think He has degrees of difficulties—that there are big things or small things, easy or difficult, possible or impossible. We have easy prayer requests and difficult prayer requests. But that is a false construct. To the infinite all finites are equal.
- The reality is that nothing is too difficult for God.

Reflection Questions

- 1.) Like Elisha's student, have you ever lost your cutting edge—your spiritual momentum—and begun to backslide into the realm of the ordinary? (Maybe you're there right now.) How did you realize what was happening?
- 2.) Eddie says, "No detail or circumstance in my life falls outside God's concern." And since most of spiritual momentum us gained or lost in the everyday affairs of life, it's good to know that God is actively involved in them. How have you sensed God's presence when you're struggling with losing your edge?
- 3.) If we're feeling spiritually dull, we shouldn't just try harder; we should cry out to God. Can you think of a time when trying harder to recover your spiritual passion didn't work?
- 4.) If you're stuck in spiritual dullness right now, where did you get off track? How can you go back to the point and recover your passion?

I have been praying for each of you to find renewed passion and determination to serve God in greater ways.
