Meet Our Guest Speaker, Dave Wall:



Dave was born and raised in Southern California. He studied abroad in England and later graduated from California State University, Long Beach, with a bachelor's degree in Health Science. After two years of working for a health maintenance organization, Dave accepted a position at the Union Gospel Mission and moved to Spokane, Washington. Working in development at UGM, Dave's heart for the poor and homeless has turned into a 30-year career engaging the partnership of the community to help them. He believes every man, woman, and child – homeless or not – is worth understanding.

Dave has been married for 32 years to Becky. Becky is a counselor at the Union Gospel Mission in Coeur d'Alene, Idaho at the Center for Women and Children. They have four adult children.

But what is the Union Gospel Mission? The UGM is a faith-based organization that provides 24/7 comprehensive emergency services and recovery programs for Spokane's poor and homeless. During Dave's tenure, the UGM has grown from two shelters to four and now includes four medical clinics, a dental and eye clinic, two thrift stores and an automotive enterprise, a summer camp for at-risk children, and an outreach center for homeless teens.
