July 21st

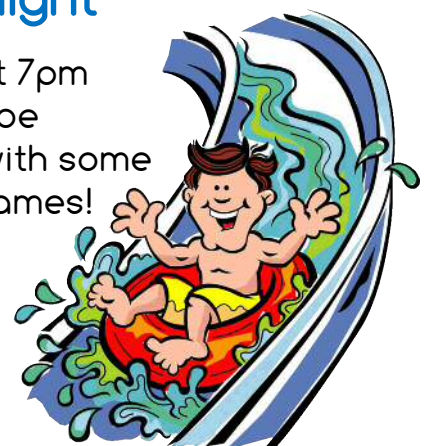
