2.) The _____ baptizes us in _____.

Luke 3:21:

"When all the people were baptized, it came to pass that Jesus also was baptized; and while He prayed, the heaven was opened."

Matthew 28:19:

"Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,"

This is water baptism, where the old person is cut off. Even Jesus was baptized in water.

3.) _____ baptizes us in or with the _____.

Matthew 3:11:

"I Indeed baptize you with water unto repentance, but He who is coming after me is mightier than I, whose sandals I am not worthy to carry. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire."

This is when we are filled to overflowing with the Holy Spirit and receive power to walk our new life in Christ and power to share the Gospel of Jesus Christ. It does not automatically happen when we are saved; it is a separate baptism. The baptism with the Holy Spirit is mentioned in each of the four gospels (Matthew 3:11, Mark 1:8, Luke 3:16, John 1:33).

These three baptisms are intended for all believers and are mentioned many times in Scripture (Acts 2:37-39, Acts 8:12-17, Acts 19:1-6, 1 John 5:7-8, 1 Corinthians 10:1-2).

Have you experienced all three baptisms? If not, talk to someone in this room or a trusted Christian friend about taking the next step toward salvation, water baptism or receiving the Holy Spirit. If yes, thank God by writing out a list of the many ways He has blessed your life.

Pray:

Lord, I thank You that no matter where I am in my journey with You, You always want to give me more of Your Holy Spirit. Please fill me to overflowing with Your Spirit today so I can have power to live a life that honors You.
