Mpact Garden Party Sleepover

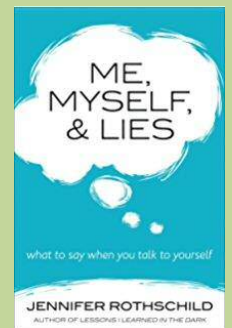
