*There is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus.*

It has a f\_\_\_\_\_ finish:

*For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord.*

Right in the middle it crosses the B\_\_\_\_\_ B\_\_\_\_\_ of the Bible:

*All things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are called according to His purpose.*

Then there's the s\_\_\_\_\_:

*In all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us.*

The h\_\_\_\_\_ on which the greatest chapter turns:

*If God is for us, who can be against us?*

What if God doesn't take His c\_\_\_\_\_ from you about you?
