Seek God

Our first priority in life is not seeking a spouse... it is seeking God.

Put God first, seek Him before all else, and let nothing else take the central place in your life that only God deserves.

The first two of the Ten Commandments (Exodus 20:3-6) address this issue:

Commandment 1: "You shall have no other gods before Me."

Commandment 2: "You shall not make for yourself an image in the form of anything . . ."

God knows that if we put Him first, love Him most, and follow Him above all, every other relationship in our life will be better, stronger, and built on a firm foundation.

Statistics show that 50 percent of marriages don't make it.

Let God be **Your One** and your spouse be **your two!**

Jesus replied: "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.' This is the first and greatest commandment. And the second is like it: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.' All the Law and the Prophets hang on these two commandments" (Matthew 22:37-40).
